Admission for School Groups

Students and Chaperones pay only \$1.00 each. (Chaperones must pay with group to qualify for the \$1.00 rate) Admission will be waived for students unable to pay the \$1.00. Pay with cash, one school check, money order, or credit card. (No personal checks will be accepted.) Have one representative pay admission and provide school name, address, phone number, number of students and chaperones paying the \$1.00, and number of admissions being waived. Enter Gate #Y at 200 North 1000 West.

Important Information

Parking is free for buses and chaperone vehicles entering directly behind the buses. Enter gate #Y at 200 North 1000 West. All others must pay regular parking fees. If you need a lunch area, picnic tables are located on the center mall, and throughout the Fairpark, or you may use any grass area available.

* FUN AND LEARNING AT THE WILDLIFE BUILDING *

Hunter Education Outreach Trailer

Learn some of the basics of safe and responsible firearms use and target shooting at the UDWR Hunter Education Trailer, located on the Northeast side of the Wildlife Building. At three stations, students will be given educational instruction in: 1) the four basic rules of firearms safety, 2) wildlife identification, 3) how to determine your dominant eye. Once students complete the three stations, they will be allowed to take 12 shots with pellet rifles at "knock down" and "spinner" targets. The trailer will be operated by the UDWR Hunter Education staff, UDWR conservation officers, and volunteer Hunter Education Instructors and will be open from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm. Pathways to Fishing - Hands On Fishing Program (for kids age 13 and under)

"Introduction to Fishing" program will begin every 30 minutes, from 4:00 pm to 7:00 pm daily, at the Kid's Fishing Pond located on the South side of the Wildlife Building. Programs consist of a 20 minute presentation about fish, their habitats and the basics of fishing. After the presentation, kids use the skills they learn to catch and release fish stocked in the pond. Instruction, fishing rods, reels, and bait are provided.
